

## **College Profile**

Govt. College Kharkhara Rewari was established by Shri Bhupender Singh Hooda, (the then Chief Minister of Haryana) in July 2011 as a co-educational Institution to cater the needs of this rural area. It is located on NH-8 Road, approx 18kms from the District Headquarter Rewari and is spread across 8.5 acres of area stretching along the border area of kharkhara village.

The college Campus has beautiful ambience, lush green and beautiful lawns, modern infrastructural facility which offers a vibrant environment to the students to indulge in extra-curricular activities with holistic approach to achieve sustainable growth of the institution. It nurtures and creates future talent among the students of this region. Its diverse and vibrant atmosphere encourages collaborative learning and stimulates intellectual curiosity.

The college is affiliated with Indira Gandhi University, Meerpur, Rewari Since the 2017. The available courses in the college are BA, B.Com, and B.SC. (Non-med). At present the college has 1007 students on its rolls from the nearby areas like Rewari, Dungerpur, Masani, Tataepur, Nikhari, Dharuhera, Kapriwas, Malpura, Kharakhara Bansroad, etc. Apart from these many students belonging to the nearby town Bhiwadi (border area of Rajasthan) take admission in college. The college has good infrastructure, facilities which include Smart class room, LT room, Multipurpose Hall, modern Seminar Hall, fully equipped Maths Lab, Geography Lab, Chemistry Lab and Physics Lab apart from three Computer labs.

The library of our college is fully equipped and air-conditioned. It has 5080 plus books of every subject being taught in the college. It has a huge sitting area with the sitting capacity of approx. 150 students at a time. Apart from the usefulness aspect, the library is aesthetically pleasing as well. The library is airy and ventilated, having multiple windows. Well lit, neat and clean, the library exudes positivity which helps students to study and prepare for their tests and exams. The library is fully updated and automated with the SOUL software. It has a computer system and printers for all students to get printouts whenever required. Students have the facility of issuing books, newspapers and magazines. Not only the reading sections for students, there is a separate cabin for college staff as well. Students are encouraged to make use of the library facilities and a help desk is set up to help them in their search for reading material in the library. The Library in-charge Mrs. Manya Bholra and Sh. Khushiram (L.A.) inspects overall for a smooth functioning.

## **Women Cell**

The Women's Cell of our college engages in impactful and empowering activities, tirelessly promoting inclusivity and gender equality. ### **Scholarship (SC, BC & Other)**

There is an SC cell in Govt. College, Kharkhara, Rewari, for the purpose of protecting the rights, addressing any kind of discrimination, promoting advocacy and representation, facilitating scholarships and financial support, counselling, guiding and giving legal Support to Scheduled Caste Students. The cell makes sure that the reservation rules pertaining to student admission is followed and it also serves as a grievance redressal cell for college staff and SC students' complaints.

There is a provision for scholarships and stipends funded by the state and central governments for SC Students to reduce the dropout rate of students. Increased Access to Education, Empowerment, Social Inclusion and Reduction of Disparities is therefore taken care off by addressing the financial challenges faced by scheduled caste and other underprivileged groups. Under the Consolidated Stipend Scheme, SC students are eligible for a yearly stipend of Rs.12, 000 and Rs.2000 for books. During the Year 2022-2023, total 194 students availed the benefits of SC Scholarship and 27 BC students applied for post matric scholarship and all were approved and 3 students received the scholarship. These schemes help and contribute to a more inclusive and supportive educational environment.

## **Other/Merit Scholarships**

In addition to scholarships specifically for students belonging to particular categories, the college also offers some scholarships purely on a merit basis.

### **STIPEND SCHEME FOR GRANDCHILDREN OF FREEDOM FIGHTERS (2010-11) PURSUING HIGHER EDUCATION IN GOVT./NON-GOVT AIDED COLLEGES OF HARYANA.**

In recognition of the third generation of grandchildren of freedom fighters, the Dept. has suggested that they be awarded a scholarship equal to that which is acceptable for children from scheduled caste families. The following may be the scholarship rate: - Rs. 2000 as a one-time book allowance and Rs. 1000 as a monthly scholarship for 12 months for colleges.

### **Scheme of Govt. of Haryana for Merit Scholarship to Under Graduate Girls Students**

This scholarship is awarded to female students enrolled in government colleges who have passed their 10+2 exam with at least 60% marks. This scheme has no income restrictions. The Scholarship is awarded to ten female students per College. Each student receives a scholarship worth Rs. 3,000 annually.

### **Haryana State Meritorious Incentive Scheme for the students who attain merit positions in Annual University Examinations.**

This scheme is college-specific and three meritorious students in each stream who stood first, second and third in the annual university examination will be given this incentive. The merit list is prepared separately for the boys (general category), Girls (general category) and SC students (Combined list of girls and boys). There is no income limit for these awards. The incentive is awarded separately for each stream i.e. Arts, Commerce and Science (Non-Medical). The student who stands first in the merit is given Rs.5000/- p.a., second - Rs.3000/- p.a. and the student who stands third in the Merit is given Rs.2000/- p.a..

**Haryana State Meritorious Incentive Scheme for the Students who attain Merit Position in CBSE annual exams.**

Under this Scheme, two students (one boy & one girl student) are given an annual Incentive based on their Top position/performance in annual CBSE 10th and 12th annual exams every year.

**SCHEME OF STATE GOVERNMENT (HARYANA EDUCATION DEPARTMENT)  
MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS IN COLLEGES FOR GENERAL UNIVERSITY**

**EDUCATION**

This scholarship is awarded to top rank-holder students in 10+2 exam and enrolled in government colleges. This scheme has no income restrictions. Each student receives a scholarship worth Rs. 3,600 annually.

**Scheme of Post Matric Scholarship to Lower Income Group Students for Studies in India.**

The object of the Scheme is to provide financial assistance to Lower Income Groups to enable them to complete their Education. The Scholarships for Lower Income Group students are awarded based on the total annual income from all sources of the parents/guardians of the applicant and not based on caste. For this purpose, the applicants are divided into two slabs one with income up to Rs.12, 000/- per annum and the other with income over Rs. 12,000/- but not exceeding Rs.2000/- per annum.

During the session 2022-2023, a total of 16 students avail the benefits of these scholarships. Out of these 5 students got benefit under the scheme of Government of Haryana for merit scholarship to under graduate girls students. 8 students got benefit under Haryana state meritorious incentive scheme and 3 students got benefit under scheme of State Govt. (Haryana Education department) merit scholarship in colleges for general university education.

**Red Cross and Red Ribbon Club**

### **Earn While You Learn**

EWYL, a Govt. of Haryana funded scheme is a regular practice in the college intended to benefit genuinely needy and meritorious students by engaging them in different departments/ laboratories. In lieu of work done, they are paid 100 rupees per hour. This is an initiative to promote dignity of labor and self-reliance in the students. The selection process is completely transparent one, where in students are judged on many factors including economic background and academic performance by a well constituted committee of senior members. In the year 2023-24, 23 students gained financial help through the scheme. Our college was granted Rs. 40000/- to be distributed among students involved. Mrs. Ekta, Assistant Professor of Commerce is the convener of the committee.

### **Placement Cell**

The Placement Cell operates with unwavering diligence, fostering a bridge between academia and industry. Its meticulous planning and strategic initiatives ensure that our students embark on promising career journeys. ## **Passport Scheme**

The State Government introduced a scheme of making passports for the UG final year students in 2020-21. The decision comes as a gift from the Haryana government to students pursuing higher studies, medical facilities, business purposes, or to meet their family. The object is to ease the process to obtain a passport and encourage students to pursue higher education. For this purpose a nodal officer was assigned and trained by the passport authorities. In Government College Kharkhara, we have a committee of 4 members headed by nodal officer Sh. Satyender Singh.

For applying passport, First of all we register the students on the online portal [www.passportindia.gov.in](http://www.passportindia.gov.in). The passport application fee of Rs. 1500/- is paid by the state government and the application is processed. It is followed by the appointment fixing by the students on the online portal and finally passports are issued to the students by the passport authority after the police verification and document verification. In our college 107 passports of the UG-final year students were successfully made till date.

## **Tour**

A group of 47 boys students (mostly final year students) went to Agra and Vrindavan (U.P) as part of one day Educational tour on 29-Nov-2023 . They were accompanied by the tour in-charge Sh. Satyender Singh and Dr. Hari Parkash. Students visited world famous and majestic ‘Tajmahal’ in pre-lunch session and historical ‘Agra fort’ post lunch session. Students-teachers enjoyed an extensive tour to Agra, the finest example of Mughal architecture because of its many Mughal-era buildings, most notably the Taj Mahal and Red Fort of which are UNESCO World Heritage Sites.
