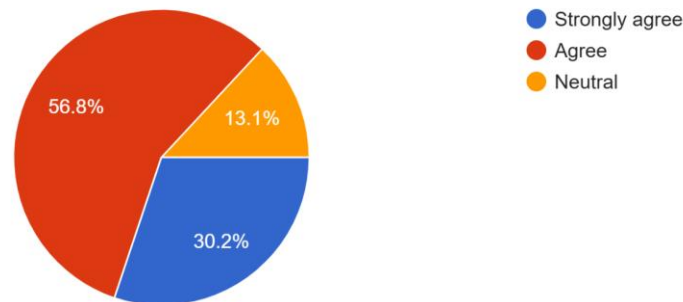

398 responses

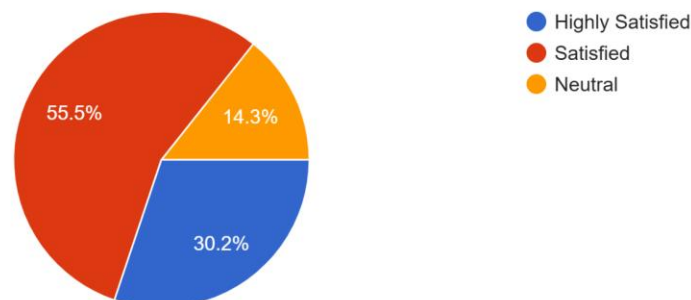


Analysis The feedback analysis indicates a generally positive perception of the curriculum, with 87% of students agreeing or strongly agreeing with its content and design. Only 13% remain neutral, suggesting room for further improvement or clarification.

We aim to address concerns raised by the 13% neutral respondents through targeted improvements and clarifications, ensuring an even more robust learning experience for all students.

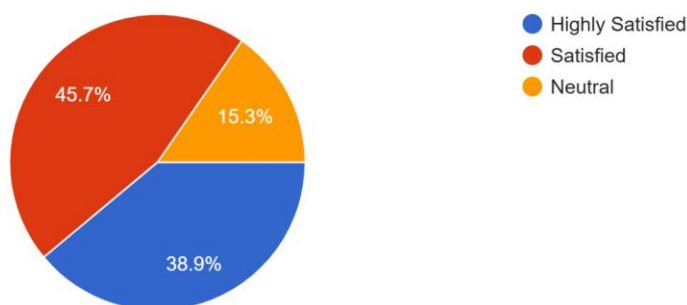

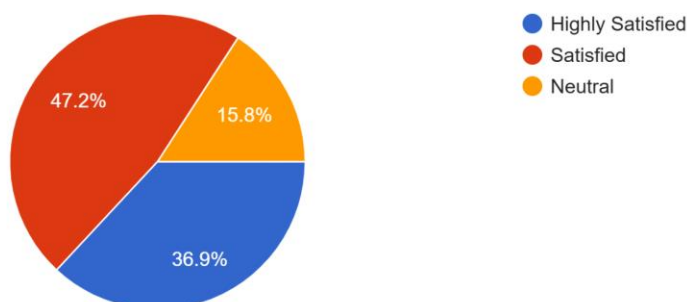

398 responses



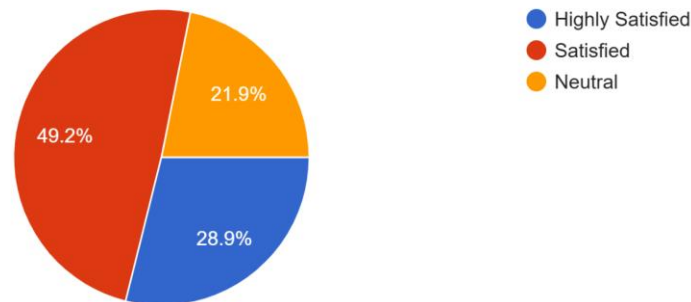

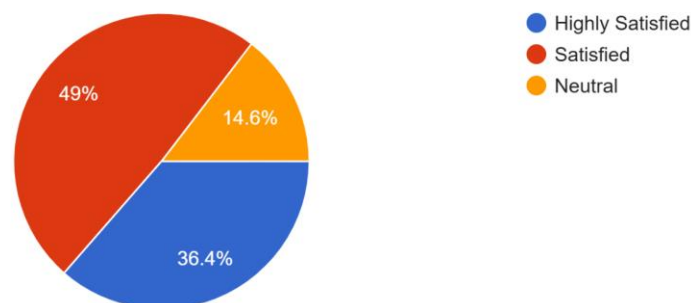

While 78% of students express satisfaction or high satisfaction, the 22% neutral responses indicate a need for further alignment to bridge potential gaps between academia and industry expectations.

Action Taken: Acknowledging the feedback, we're collaborating with industry experts to enhance curriculum relevance. Initiatives include updating course content, incorporating practical applications, and offering industry-specific projects. 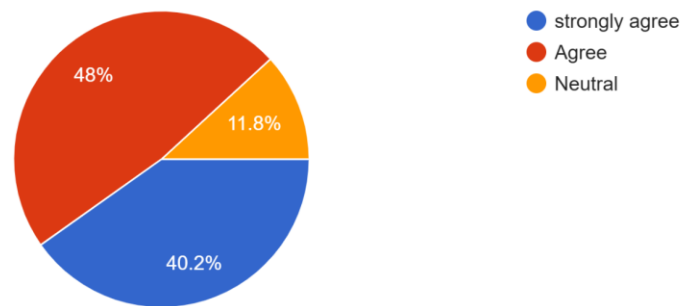

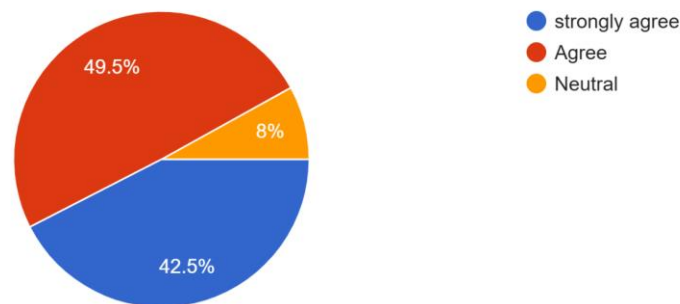

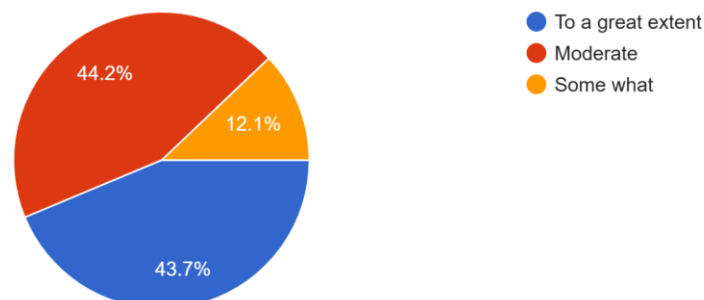

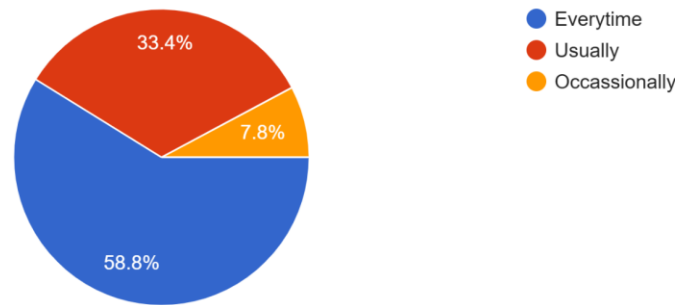

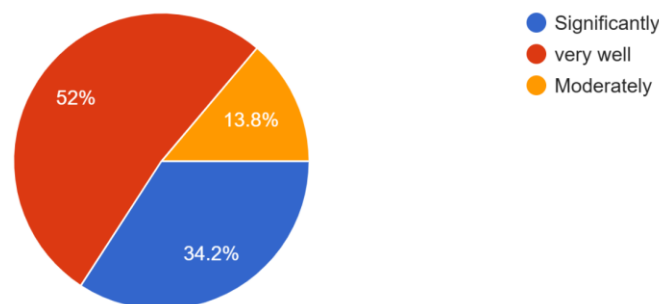
Teachers/institution inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes

Analysis: Feedback analysis reveals that 59% of students report always receiving information on expected competencies, course outcomes, and program outcomes from teachers/institutions. 33% state it's usually provided, while 8% indicate occasional communication, highlighting room for improvement in clarity and consistency.

Action Taken: Following feedback analysis, several actions have been taken to ensure clarity and consistency in communicating expected competencies, course outcomes, and program outcomes. Regular orientations are conducted to reinforce understanding, structured communication protocols are implemented, and feedback loops are established to address occasional gaps in information dissemination.

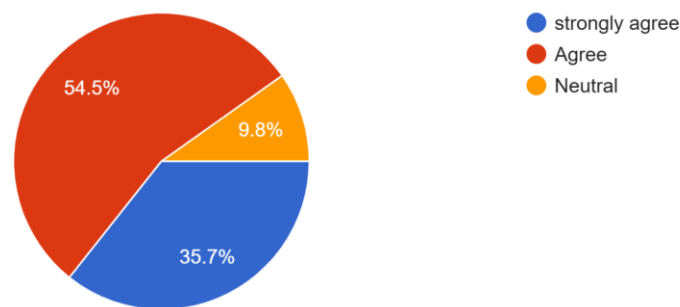

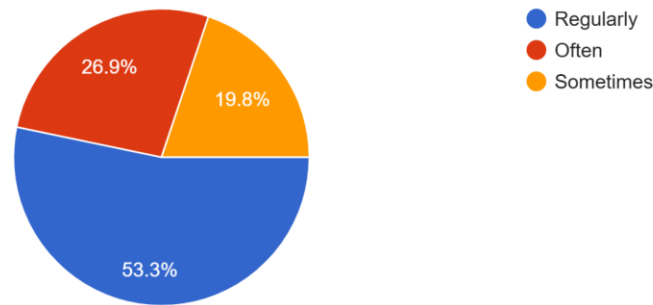

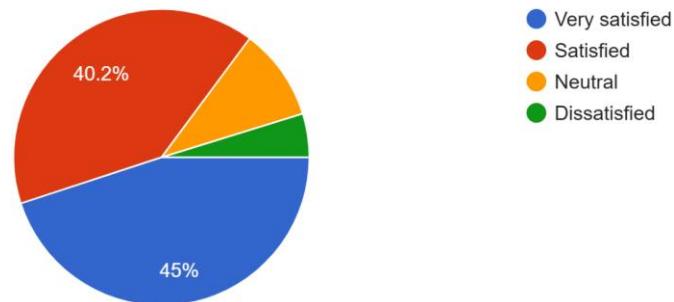
Analysis: Feedback analysis indicates that 53% of students report the institute regularly promotes internships, student exchange, field visits, and sports opportunities. Additionally, 27% state these opportunities are often provided, while 20% perceive them to be sometimes available, highlighting varied engagement levels among students.

Action Taken: Based on the feedback analysis, initiatives have been undertaken to enhance student engagement opportunities. Efforts include expanding internship partnerships, fostering more frequent student exchanges (Many students participated in Inter-College Competition held at GC Sidhrawali, GC Pataudi, GCW Rewari, and GC Mahendergarh and students from other colleges also participated in our college 1st cultural fest Spectrum), organizing additional field visits, and diversifying sports programs (IGU Meerpur organised Inter-College Sports Trial in our college). These actions aim to address varying student preferences and ensure comprehensive experiential learning experiences.

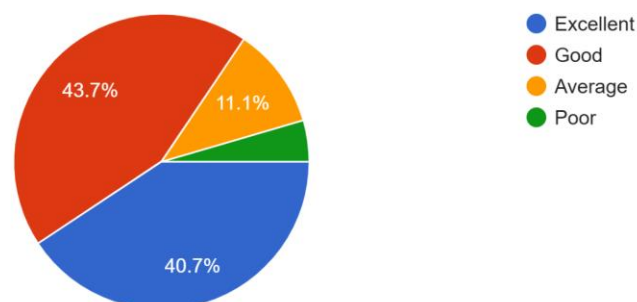


Analysis: Feedback analysis reveals that 45% of students were very satisfied, while 40% were satisfied with the library facilities. This indicates a majority expressing high satisfaction levels, reflecting positively on the quality and accessibility of resources provided by the library.

Action Taken: Following feedback analysis, measures have been initiated to maintain and enhance library facilities. Actions include regular maintenance to ensure optimal functionality, procurement of additional resources based on student feedback, and implementing user-friendly policies to further improve satisfaction levels and meet student needs effectively.

Analysis: Feedback analysis indicates that 41% of students rate the overall accessibility of library resources as excellent, with 44% considering it good. However, 11% perceive it as average. This suggests generally positive sentiments regarding resource accessibility, albeit with some room for improvement.

Action Taken: Based on feedback analysis, actions have been implemented to further enhance the accessibility of library resources. These include streamlining cataloguing systems, expanding digital collections, and providing additional support services. Continuous monitoring ensures alignment with student expectations and ongoing improvements to meet diverse needs effectively.

Analysis of Suggestions given by Students: Feedback analysis reveals mixed sentiments among students. While 34% acknowledge the college positively, 37% abstain from suggestions. However, 20% express averageness. Specific requests include a canteen, enhanced sports facilities, improved computer labs, and the introduction of a gym. Very few complaints are noted regarding cleanliness, signalling overall satisfaction with the college environment.

Action Taken Report on Suggestions given by Students: Based on feedback, actions have been initiated to address student suggestions. Computer lab issues are being resolved promptly. A gym will be operational from the upcoming academic session. Efforts are focused on enhancing sports facilities and cleanliness. Regular maintenance ensures computers in labs are fully functional. These actions aim to improve overall satisfaction and meet student expectations effectively.

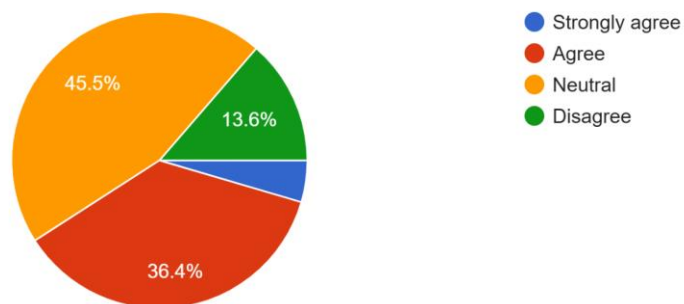

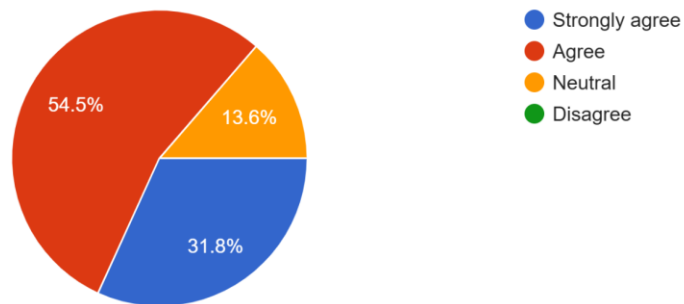

FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

Positive Aspects:

1. **Syllabus Balance and Learning Objectives:** 17 out of 20 staff members agree that the syllabus has a good balance between theory and application, and learning objectives are well-designed.
2. **Use of New Teaching Tools:** All 20 staff members are using new teaching tools and methodologies, and 18 agree that infrastructural facilities support these methods.
3. **Faculty Support and Freedom:** 17 staff members feel supported in upgrading their skills, and a similar number feel they have the freedom to adopt new testing and assessment techniques.
4. **Library and Reference Materials:** 18 staff members find the reference materials relevant and sufficient in the library.

Areas for Improvement:

1. **Curriculum Industry Alignment:** While 8 staff members agree and 9 are neutral, more focus could be placed on aligning curriculum content with industrial requirements.
2. **Student Attendance and Administrative Burden:** Suggestions include improving student attendance strategies and reducing administrative workload for teachers.
3. **Infrastructure:** Requests include more smart classrooms, improved lab infrastructure, and subscribing to more journals in the library.

Feedback Analysis Report

Detailed Analysis:

1. **Admission Procedure:** 21 out of 25 parents rated the admission procedure as either good or excellent.
2. **Student counselling and Guidance:** 18 out of 25 parents rated the counselling and guidance services as either satisfactory or highly satisfactory.
3. **Academic Discipline:** 21 out of 25 parents rated the academic discipline, including timely conduct of lectures and practical, as either satisfactory or highly satisfactory.
4. **Examination System:** 21 out of 25 parents rated the examination system as either satisfactory or highly satisfactory.

5. **Curriculum Content and Design:** 20 out of 25 parents rated the curriculum content and design as satisfactory or highly satisfactory.
6. **Infrastructure Facilities:** 19 out of 25 parents rated the availability of laboratory, library, and other infrastructure facilities as satisfactory or highly satisfactory.

8. **Suggestions:** Many parents provided suggestions such as:

4. **Introduce NCC Program:**
 - Establish an NCC unit in the college to provide students with opportunities for holistic development, including leadership and teamwork skills.
5. **Upgrade Toilet Facilities:**
 - Ensure that there are adequate and well-maintained toilet facilities available for all students. Immediate attention should be given to any areas lacking such amenities.
6. **Enhance Sports and Recreational Facilities:**

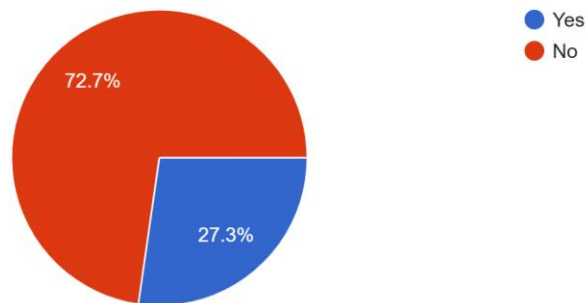

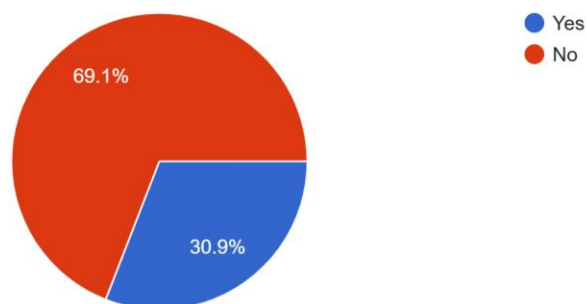

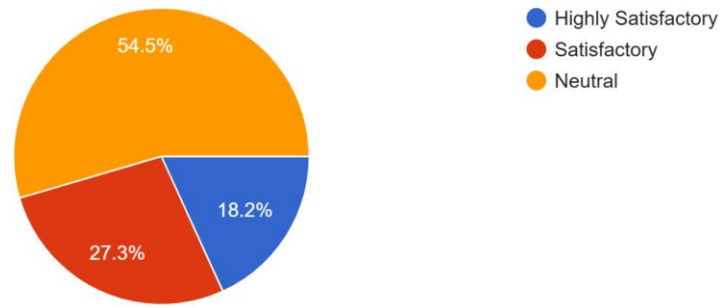

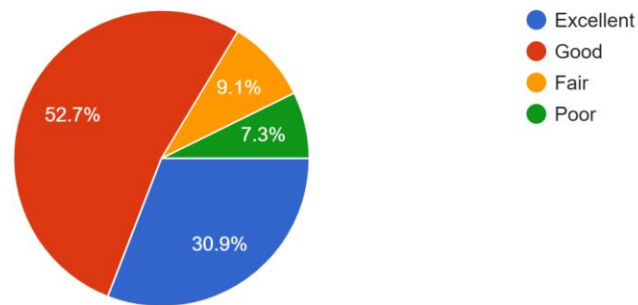
Relevance of content of curriculum with current job/ Occupation

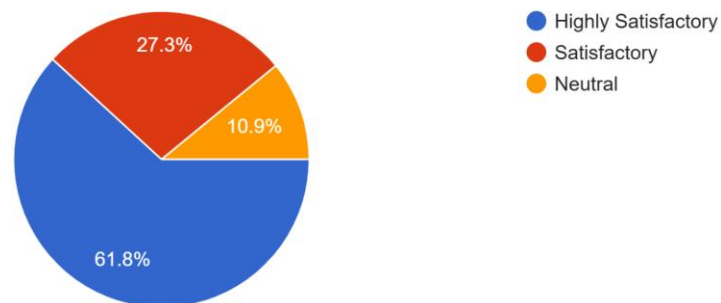

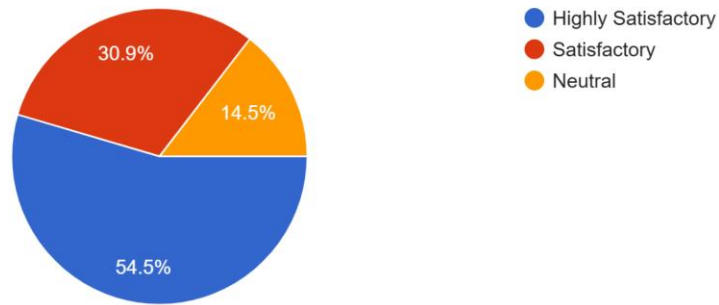
Student teacher interaction

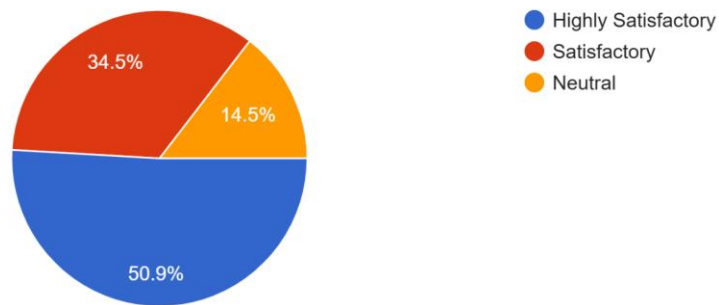
Cooperation from teachers and other college staff*

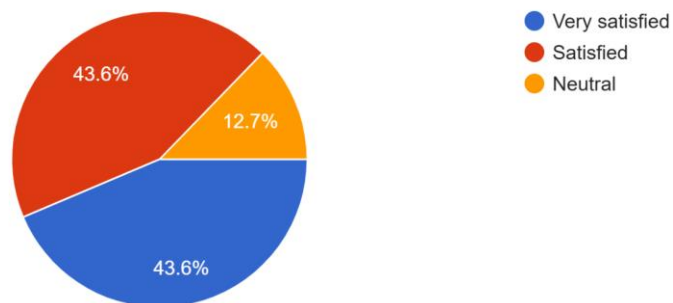
Involvement of teachers in college activities for teaching and other extra-curriculum activities

Feedback Analysis Report:

Alumni feedback was collected from 54 pass-out students of different years, revealing valuable insights:

1. **Higher Studies:** 34 out of 54 alumni are pursuing further studies such as M.Sc, MBA, M.A, B.Ed, etc., from various colleges and universities.
2. **Employment Status:** 39 alumni are currently unemployed, while the majority of the 15 employed alumni work in the private sector.
3. **Self-Employment:** 37 out of 54 alumni reported they are not self-employed.
4. **Curriculum Relevance:** 25 alumni rated the relevance of the curriculum content to their current job as satisfactory or highly satisfactory, while 29 remained neutral.
5. **Infrastructure and Facilities:** 45 out of 54 alumni rated the college's infrastructure, labs, and library facilities as excellent or good.
6. **Student-Teacher Interaction:** 48 alumni expressed satisfaction or high satisfaction with student-teacher interactions.
7. **Teacher and Staff Cooperation:** 46 alumni reported satisfactory or highly satisfactory experiences with the cooperation from teachers and staff.
8. **Involvement in Activities:** 46 alumni were satisfied or highly satisfied with teachers' involvement in both teaching and extracurricular activities.
9. **Overall Facilities:** 46 alumni were satisfied or very satisfied with the overall facilities provided by the college as per the curriculum.
10. **Suggestions:** Most suggestions from alumni praised the current state and encouraged maintaining the standards.

Recommendations:

- **Employment Support:** Enhance career counseling and job placement services to address the high unemployment rate among alumni.
- **Entrepreneurship Programs:** Introduce programs and workshops to encourage and support self-employment among students.

- **Continued Facility Improvement:** Maintain and further develop the college's infrastructure, labs, and library facilities to sustain high satisfaction levels.

- **Strengthen Student-Teacher Interaction:** Continue fostering strong student-teacher relationships through mentorship programs and interactive teaching methods.
- **Extra-Curricular Activities:** Expand extracurricular and co-curricular activities to provide a holistic development environment for students.
- **Alumni Network:** Establish a robust alumni network for continuous feedback and engagement, ensuring ongoing improvement and support for current students.
