

Student Feedback Analysis Report

Session 2021-22

The feedback analysis reveals that the majority of students are satisfied with the college's performance across various parameters. Specifically, 57.71% rate the relevance of the syllabus to recent trends as excellent, while 41.29% rate it as good. Syllabus coverage in class also received positive feedback, with 46.27% rating it as excellent and 38.81% as good. Teachers' illustration of concepts through examples and applications was rated excellent by 46.27% and good by 42.79%.

The usage of ICT tools during teaching received 46.77% excellent and 37.31% good ratings, indicating room for improvement. Teacher preparedness for classes is well-regarded, with 53.23% rating it as excellent. The fairness of internal evaluation and discussion of assignment outcomes are areas that can be improved, with lower percentages in the excellent category.

Promotion of internships and field visits is appreciated, with 46.77% rating it as excellent. Courses have enhanced students' knowledge and skills, with 60.20% rating it as excellent. Teacher availability after lecture timings is also satisfactory, with 46.77% rating it as excellent.

Provisions for extracurricular activities received positive feedback, with 47.76% rating it as excellent. The overall program and facilities were rated excellent by 46.77%. College facilities, such as classrooms and libraries, received a 48.26% excellent rating, while campus safety and security measures were rated excellent by 56.22%.

Recommendations:

- 1. **Improve ICT Tools Usage**: Enhance the use of ICT tools in teaching to increase student engagement and learning efficiency.
- 2. Assignment Outcome Discussions: Facilitate more thorough and constructive discussions on assignment outcomes to help students understand their performance better.
- 3. **Internal Evaluation Process**: Ensure fairness and transparency in the internal evaluation process to maintain student trust and satisfaction.
- 4. **Extracurricular Activities**: Expand and diversify extracurricular and co-curricular activities to cater to a wider range of interests and enhance student development.
- 5. **Teacher Accessibility**: Encourage teachers to be more available and accessible outside lecture hours for student consultations and support.

Overall, while the feedback is largely positive, focusing on these areas for improvement can further enhance the student experience and satisfaction.

Action Taken Report:

In response to the feedback received, several initiatives have been implemented to enhance the educational experience. In 2022, a state-of-the-art digital math lab was constructed, providing students with advanced tools for learning and exploration. Additionally, a fully-equipped seminar hall with comprehensive ICT facilities was established, enabling effective multimedia teaching and interactive sessions. To further enrich the student experience, numerous extracurricular and co-curricular activities have been organized, promoting holistic development and engagement beyond the classroom. These measures aim to address the identified areas for improvement and ensure a supportive and dynamic learning environment for all students.



General Feedback Analysis Report

The feedback collected from 23 respondents provides a comprehensive overview of various aspects of the college's curriculum, teaching methodologies, and resources.

Syllabus Balance: The syllabus of the courses is generally perceived to have a good balance between theory and application, with 7 respondents (30.43%) strongly agreeing and 15 (65.22%) agreeing. Only 1 respondent (4.35%) remained neutral, and none disagreed.

Learning Objectives: Learning objectives of the curriculum are well-defined, as indicated by 8 respondents (34.78%) who strongly agree and 15 (65.22%) who agree. There were no neutral or disagreeing responses.

Curriculum Content: The content of the curriculum aligns with industrial requirements, with 3 respondents (13.04%) strongly agreeing and 16 (69.57%) agreeing. However, 3 respondents (13.04%) remained neutral, and 1 respondent (4.35%) disagreed.

Faculty Support: The College provides adequate opportunities and support for faculty members to upgrade their skills and qualifications. This is supported by 9 respondents (39.13%) who strongly agree and 12 (52.17%) who agree. There were 2 neutral responses (8.70%), and no disagreements.

Teaching Environment: The environment in the college is conducive to teaching and research, with 8 respondents (34.78%) strongly agreeing and 12 (52.17%) agreeing. However, 3 respondents (13.04%) remained neutral.

Teaching Tools and Methodologies: The use of new teaching tools or methodologies, such as ICT, is prevalent, with a significant 22 respondents (95.65%) strongly agreeing and only 1 respondent (4.35%) agreeing.

Infrastructural Facilities: Infrastructural facilities for using new teaching tools and methodologies are available, as noted by 7 respondents (30.43%) who strongly agree and 14 (60.87%) who agree. There were 2 neutral responses (8.70%).

Reference Materials: The books and journals prescribed or listed as reference materials are relevant, updated, and cover the entire syllabi, with 7 respondents (30.43%) strongly agreeing and 16 (69.57%) agreeing.

Freedom in Teaching Techniques: Faculty members feel they have the freedom to adopt new techniques and strategies for testing and assessing students, with 10 respondents (43.48%) strongly agreeing and 13 (56.52%) agreeing.

Library Resources: The availability of prescribed books in the library is sufficient, as indicated by 16 respondents (69.57%) who strongly agree. However, 7 respondents (30.43%) disagreed.

Recommendations

1. Enhance Office Administration:

• Improve administrative efficiency to provide better support to faculty and students.

2. Increase Class IV Employees:

• Address the need for additional support staff to maintain the college facilities and ensure smooth operations.

3. Expand Reference Books Collection:

• Continue updating and expanding the library's collection to meet the academic needs of both faculty and students.

4. Develop Smart Class Rooms:

• Invest in creating more smart classrooms equipped with modern teaching tools to facilitate interactive learning.

Action Taken

1. Books Purchased in 2022-23:

• The library has been updated with new books to enhance academic resources.

2. Construction of Smart Rooms:

• A digital maths lab and a seminar hall equipped with podiums and smart screens have been constructed to provide state-of-the-art learning environments.

3. Enhanced Facilities:

• The seminar hall is fully functional with all necessary ICT facilities to support various academic and extracurricular activities.

Government College Kharkhara Parents Feedback Session 2021-22 Analysis Report

- **1.** The feedback analysis reveals that all parents are quite satisfied with the quality of education provided by the college, with no dissatisfaction reported.
- **2.** The majority of parents indicated that the college is somewhat accessible, while the rest rated it as highly accessible. No parents reported that the college is not accessible.
- **3.** The majority of parents were satisfied with the communication between the college and parents, while the rest were very satisfied. No parents reported being dissatisfied.
- **4.** Half of the parents rated the college's efforts to meet their child's educational needs as effective, while the other half rated them as very effective. No parents found the efforts to be ineffective.
- **5.** The majority of parents were very satisfied with the college's facilities and condition. A few were satisfied, and no parents reported being dissatisfied.
- **6.** Half of the parents felt that the college supports extracurricular activities very well, while the rest felt it is supported well. One parent felt it is supported not well.
- **7.** A few parents felt that the availability of teaching materials and resources is very sufficient, most found it to be sufficient, and no one considered it insufficient.
- 8. Equal numbers of parents rated the college's approach to student safety and discipline as excellent and good. No parents rated it as poor.
- **9.** Almost equal numbers of parents agreed that the college is either very helpful or helpful in involving them in college activities. No parents found the college to be not helpful.
- 10. The majority of parents indicated that they would be very likely to recommend the college to other parents, while a few said there is somewhat likely to recommend it. No parents said there is no likelihood of recommending the college.

Recommendations:

- 1. **Enhance Accessibility:** Continue efforts to improve accessibility for all students, considering the mixed responses on the college's accessibility.
- 2. **Support for Extracurricular:** Maintain and potentially expand support for extracurricular activities to ensure that it meets the needs of all students.
- 3. **Parental Involvement:** Increase initiatives to involve parents in college activities, leveraging the positive feedback to further engage them.

- 4. **Resource Availability:** Continue to ensure the availability of teaching materials and resources remains high, addressing any gaps as needed.
- 5. **Student Safety and Discipline:** Maintain the high standards of student safety and discipline, as this is a strong point of satisfaction.




