Government College Kharkhara, Rewari Teacher Feedback Session 2019-20 Analysis Report

The feedback indicates that while the college managed the transition to online teaching fairly well, there were significant challenges in areas such as student engagement and the effectiveness of the online examination system. The majority of teachers were satisfied with the training provided for online tools, though accessibility to online resources and mental health support could be improved. Despite some technical difficulties, the college's overall handling of the pandemic was seen as positive, with a strong emphasis on professional development opportunities.

Recommendations

Based on the feedback analysis, it is recommended to enhance the online teaching transition by providing additional training and support through regular workshops. Improving the accessibility of online resources and addressing technical issues by upgrading IT infrastructure and establishing a dedicated helpdesk is crucial. To increase student engagement, more interactive tools should be introduced. Mental health and wellness support must be made more accessible, and the online examination system should be reviewed and improved. Lastly, expanding professional development opportunities will further enhance faculty skills and adaptability, ensuring continuous improvement in educational practices.

Action Taken

Teachers were informed about online workshops through the official WhatsApp group, while separate WhatsApp groups were formed for students to facilitate communication. Online videos providing technical assistance were shared with both teachers and students. A Google Form was circulated to assess students' access to mobile devices, and feedback on their COVID-19 situation was collected. Classes were conducted by individual subject teachers, ensuring continued learning during the pandemic.







Scheduled organization of assignments, class tests and seminars. 1,567 responses


Usage of Innovative Teaching Methodologies. 1,567 responses






Do you feel that security measures provided in the college premises are adequate? 1,560 responses


Are you satisfied with the infrastructure (sports and laboratories)? 1,566 responses






Availability of general books and related to your subject?





How effectively is discipline maintained in the College? 1,563 responses








Do you think that rules and regulations are followed in a strict manner during examinations? 1,562 responses
