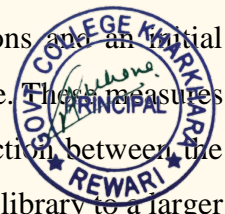
Response: Action taken report on the feedback analysis

Session 2023-24

Based on comprehensive feedback analysis, several actions have been taken to address student, teacher, parent, and alumni suggestions. For students, prompt resolution of computer lab issues is underway, and a gym will be equipped with more facilities from the upcoming academic session. Efforts are being made to enhance sports facilities and maintain cleanliness. Regular maintenance ensures computer labs are fully functional. In response to teachers' feedback, workshops and ongoing training are being implemented to maintain high levels of expertise, and curriculum alignment with NEP 2020 is being pursued. MOUs with industries have been signed to improve curriculum relevance, and initiatives like mentor groups and PTMs are planned to address student attendance.

For parents, regular updates and increased focus on cleanliness are being prioritized. Communication with Haryana Roadways aims to improve transportation facilities, while an established indoor gym will enhance recreational opportunities. Regular PTMs will be introduced to address parent concerns effectively. Additionally, the library has been relocated and expanded, with new books purchased to support academic research.

Alumni feedback has led to the signing of an MOU for academic and professional development, the organization of workshops and job fairs, and the creation of an alumni WhatsApp group for mentorship. The alumni association has been formalized with successful elections and an initial meeting, with ongoing registration efforts to build a comprehensive alumni database. These measures aim to enhance overall satisfaction, improve facilities, and strengthen the connection between the institution and its stakeholders. Infrastructure improvements include relocating the library to a larger space and expanding its collection. The college also organized its first cultural fest, "Spectrum," to boost student engagement in co-curricular activities. These actions collectively aim to address the feedback and enhance the overall quality of the college experience.



Session 2022-23

Based on the feedback analysis of college infrastructure and academic resources, several key actions have been undertaken to address the concerns raised. To enhance digital connectivity, improvements to Wi-Fi and internet facilities have been prioritized, ensuring each department is equipped with reliable access. The college is also in the process of establishing a new canteen facility to better serve the student body. Regular inspections and maintenance schedules have been implemented to ensure high standards of cleanliness in the toilets. Campus security has been bolstered through increased surveillance, better lighting, and additional personnel.

In response to academic feedback, the college has upgraded sports facilities, including the approval of a new gym and a dedicated budget for sports equipment. Student redressal mechanisms have been streamlined for more effective grievance resolution, and CCTV systems have been expanded for enhanced campus monitoring. Efforts have been made to optimize classroom usage and improve the quality of drinking water through advanced purification systems.

Furthermore, the college has introduced ICT training for teachers, diversified teaching methods, and reinforced fair evaluation practices. Session 2021-22

The library has been updated with new books, expanding academic resources for students. Smart rooms, including the new digital math lab and seminar hall with podiums and smart screens, provide cutting-edge learning environments. The seminar hall now supports various academic and extracurricular activities with its advanced ICT capabilities. Furthermore, programs to increase student participation in extracurricular activities have been implemented, and the discipline committee's authority and processes have been strengthened to ensure high standards of student conduct. These measures collectively aim to address areas for improvement and create a supportive and dynamic learning environment for all students.



Session 2020-21

In response to recent feedback, the college has undertaken several measures to improve the educational experience. Teachers participated in online workshops to enhance their digital teaching skills, and a user-friendly online platform was implemented to facilitate resource access for students. Assignments are now submitted online via email and Google Forms, though financial constraints have posed challenges for some students in accessing these digital tools, highlighting the need for more accessible solutions.

Teachers have been instructed to conduct more frequent checks of lab notebooks to improve academic rigor and accountability. Administrative cooperation has been enhanced to streamline student services, and the Discipline Committee's role has been reinforced to uphold discipline standards effectively across the campus. These actions collectively aim to address the feedback and improve the overall quality of the college experience.

Session 2019-20

Based on a thorough analysis of student feedback, several strategic actions have been planned to enhance the educational experience. Teachers were informed about online workshops through an official WhatsApp group, and separate groups were created for students to facilitate communication. Online videos offering technical assistance were shared with both teachers and students, and a Google Form was used to assess students' access to mobile devices and gather feedback on their COVID-19 situation. Individual subject teachers conducted classes to ensure continued learning during the pandemic.




