

Inspection Report

The inspection committee comprising of Dr Karan Singh, Department of Chemistry, IGU, Meerpur-Rewari, Dr Surjeet Singh Dabas, Department of Yoga, IGU, Meerpur-Rewari, and Dr Suresh Malik, CBLU Bhiwani was constituted by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, IGU, Meerpur-Rewari regarding the ex-post facto Provisional Affiliation for starting new subject of Physical Education in B.A. from the session 2019-20 as well as its extension/continuation for 2nd & 3rd year, at Government College, Kharkhara, Rewari.

The following committee members visited the premises of Government College, Kharkhara, Rewari for re-inspection on 01.02.2022 (Tuesday) as on 9th December 2021, Dr Suresh Malik, CBLU, Bhiwani could not visit the college due to some personal problem.

3. Dr Suresh Malik, Member, CBLU, Bhiwani

As per the college record, the new subject of Physical education in B.A. was adopted by 50 students in 2019-20, 39 students in 2020-21 and 74 students in 2021-22 sessions.

The observations of the Committee members are as follows:

Infrastructural facilities: The College is well established and currently running B.A., B.Com and B.Sc. courses in the campus. The starting and running of new subject of Physical Education in B.A. is not required extra infrastructural facilities.


Faculty: The College has confirmed the availability of one subject teacher. The number of supporting staff is two (01 regular and 01 Part-II)

Other support system: The College has a play ground for sports/Physical exercise; auditorium/seminar hall; separate common room for staff, girls and boys; separate toilets for male, female students and staff. The Library is spacious having 4669 books and having reading hall capacity for ~100 students. The Library has internet facility along with photocopy services for staff as well as students. The College has a large hall on 1st floor which can be used for indoor sports facility.

Deficiency: Availability of number of books for the specified subject is not sufficient. The college informed us that order for physical education books are under process. The college should purchase more books of latest edition as per the syllabus of the subject. Minimum one more subject teacher is required as per workload provided.

Recommendations: Keeping in view of the above, the inspection Committee recommends grants of the ex-post facto Provisional Affiliation for starting new subject of Physical Education in B.A. from the session 2019-20 as well as its extension/continuation for 2nd & 3rd year, at Government College, Kharkhara, Rewari.


The above recommendations are subject to the compliance of the deficiencies mentioned above.

Inspection Report

Subject: Inspection report of Government College, Kharkhara (Rewari)

This is with reference to letter no. IGU/CB/2399, dated 25.07.2022 and letter no. IGU/CB/2423, dated 26.07.2022, the inspection committee comprising of Dr. Vipin Kumar (Deptt. of Geography, IG.G. Uni., Rewari), Dr. Reena (F.L.T.M.S.B.P. Govt. Girls College, Rewari) and Dr. Dheeraj (F.L.T.M.S.B.P. Govt. Girls College, Rewari) visited the premises of Government College, Kharkhara (Rewari) on 10.08.2022 regarding provisional affiliation for increasing of intake of one unit (80 seats) in B.A course form the session 2022-23.

The observations of inspection committee are as follow-

Courses- The College is offering B.A., B.Com and B.Sc. programme with an intake of 240 (B.A), 160 (B.Com.) and 80 (B.Sc.) in last session. The total strength of (Part I, II & III) in these courses for session 2021-22 is 518 (B.A.), 333 (B.Com.) and 156 (B.Sc.)

The college is offering following papers in B.A. (Pass course)

English, Hindi (Compulsory), Geography, Political Science, History, Mathematics, Physical Education and Economic.

The G.C. Kharkhara (Rewari) has total strength of 1007 students. (Annexure- XIV, page no.- 44)

Infrastructure

The college has 15 separate classrooms (only for B.A. classes), 01 smart classroom, 01 seminar/conference hall, 01 multi-purpose hall, 01 girls common room, 09 washrooms, 02 ramps for physically challenged students, 05 well equipped labs (03 Geography, 01 English Language lab, Physical Education- 01 Badminton court, 01 Table Tennis court, 01 Carom board court, 01 indoor games hall). (Annexure- IV, pp 18-19)

It has one well established library including 2 reading rooms, 20 cabins, 1750 books for B.A. pass course (including 420- English, 252 Hindi, 152 History, 114 Geography, 303 Political Geography, 60 Physical Education, 84 Economics, 334 Mathematics). (Annexure- VIII, p- 21)

Committees

The college has total 73 committees including IQAC, SC cell, RTI cell, Student grievances cell, NSS, YRC, Anti ragging/sexual harassment cell, women cell, Library committee, Legal cell etc. (Annexure- XI, pp 24-28)



Teaching Staff

The college has a regular Principal and submitted a list of 26 Assistant/Associate Professors (16 regular + 10 extension) out of which 17 are teaching B.A. pass course papers, (Annexure-IV, p 15). The college has 16 sanctioned posts out of which 14 are filled and two are vacant. As per workload 10 posts are required. (Annexure- XIII, p- 35). As per Higher Education Department Haryana, order number DHE-020012/20/2021C-1(E-5175080 dated 21.04.2022, the college has 17 new sanction posts. (Annexure- XII, pp 30-34).

Non-teaching Staff


The College has submitted a list of 09 efficient non-teaching staff and 11 required non teaching staff members (Annexure- V, pp 16).

Specific Observation

As per record, the college had an approved intake of 320 in B.A. pass course during 2019-2020 (Annexure-I, p- 6), but in 2021-22 session 80 seats in B.A. were withdrawn vide letter no. DHE-020002/2/2021-college -I DHE, dated 26.08.2021 (Annexure-II, p-7), Now, with reference to Memo no. DHE-01/042022 C-1(4), Dated 13/07/2022, Higher Education Department, Panchkula, has given the permission to increase one unit (80 students) in the Government College Kharkhara (Annexure-III, p-8).

Recommendation

The committee is of the view that ~~the college may be allowed~~ one more unit of 80 students in B.A (Pass Course) programme (English, Hindi, History, Economics, Geography, Political Science, Mathematics & Physical Education) ^{may be allowed} at Government College Kharkhara for the session 2022-23. Further, the college is being asked to communicate the higher authorities for transferring/deputing the required teaching and non-teaching staff in the interest of the students in the college.





1. The college aims at continuous improvement of quality and achieving academic excellence
